INTRODUCTION

Sngap Syiem College was set up by the Maharam Syiemship Higher Education Association in April, 1985. It is named after Sngap Syiem, the then Syiem of Maharam and the freedom fighter against the British regime. The motto of the College is “Arise and Shine”. The College was provisionally affiliated to the North Eastern Hill University, Shillong at the Pre-University level on the 12th May, 1986. The privilege of upgradation to the Degree level was extended by the University on the 3rd March, 1992. And a provisional affiliation for Honours was granted on the 8th June, 2000. The North Eastern Hill University granted permanent affiliation to this College on the 28th June, 2003.

This College is the only institution to impart higher education to the poor boys and girls from about one hundred nearby and remote villages of the area.

ADMISSION

Admission is taken on a first-come first-served basis. Eligible applicants may collect the prescribed forms for admission from the College Office and are required to submit the filled-in Application forms along with attested copies of documents as per the time-schedule displayed on the College Notice Board soon after the declaration of MBOSE Results. **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

Selected Candidate will have to collect the bill book and deposit the required fees for Admission etc., to the Meghalaya Co-operative Apex Bank Ltd. Mawkyrwat Branch as per the time schedule notified in the College notice board.

COURSES AND COMBINATION OF SUBJECTS

(A) H.S.S.L.C (ARTS)

Compulsory Subjects: English, MIL.Khasi/Alternative English & Environmental Education.

Elective Subjects:

A candidate may offer any three subjects from the following:-

Political Science, (Economics/Philosophy), History, Education, Elective English and Elective Khasi, Computer

Additional Subjects:

Students may offer any of the elective subjects as an additional subject.

(B) H.S.S.L.C (COMMERCE)

Compulsory Subjects: English, Khasi.MIL/Alternative English, Environmental Education, Economics, Accountancy, Business Studies.

Additional Subject (Any one of the following)

(Mathematics/Entrepreneurship/Computer Applications)

(C) H.S.S.L.C. (SCIENCE):

Compulsory Subjects: English, MIL.Khasi/Alternative English, Environmental Education, Chemistry, Physics, Elective subject.

Elective Subjects: (*Students may offer any one subject from the following*): Biology, Mathematics, Computer Applications.

Additional Subjects: A Candidate may offer any one of the elective subjects as an additional subject other than the subject selected as elective subject.

ADMISSION RULES AND ELIGIBILITY

1. Admission is granted strictly on merit, subject to availability of seats.
2. A minimum percentage of marks is earmarked to the eligible to apply for Science and Commerce streams which is presently as follows:
 - (a) **Science:** 45% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in Mathematics and Science in S.S.L.C or equivalent examinations.
 - (b) **Commerce:** 45% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in Mathematics and English in S.S.L.C or equivalent examinations.
 - (c) **Arts:** An S.S.L.C holder.

UNIFORM:

All 10+2 students are required to wear the college Uniforms.

ATTENDANCE:

Daily attendance for all the Students is compulsory. Students attending less than 75% of lectures shall not be permitted to sit for the examinations.

REGISTRATION:

After admission to Class XI, students must collect the registration form from the College Office for registering themselves with MBOSE.

CONDUCT OF STUDENTS

1. All students must be well behaved at all times. They should be polite, obedient and respectful to teachers and others.
2. Every student must attend classes regularly. If any student's attendance is less than 75% of the total lectures then he/she will not be allowed to sit for the examination.
3. All students must wear uniforms decently and modestly. They must see that the classrooms and the College campus is clean. They must not throw any rubbish or do anything to destroy or deface the building or the compound.
4. No student should be found smoking within the College compound.
5. Students must not adopt any unfair means especially during Examinations. Anyone found doing so shall be expelled. Such students will not be re-admitted the following year.
6. All students are entitled to a maximum of four books from the library. It can be retained for a maximum period of fourteen days. Before Promotion/ Board Examinations, all books must be returned without damage. In the event of loss or damage, it must be replaced by the concerned students.
7. It is compulsory for all students to partake in every co-curricular activities conducted by the College.
8. Students must see the notice board every day. Ignorance of any notification displayed on the notice board will not be accepted as an excuse.
9. Using Mobile phone is strictly prohibited inside the campus.

10. No society/association can be formed by students in the college without the permission of the Principal nor shall any person be invited to address a meeting in the college without prior permission of the Principal.
11. Attendance in all tests/examinations is compulsory.

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

The College offers Hostel Facilities for girl students. Students who desire to stay in the hostel must contact the Hostel's Warden. Hostel's Fee is Rs. 6000/- Per annum.

For fooding, hostellers need to make arrangement among themselves collectively under the supervision of the Warden.
