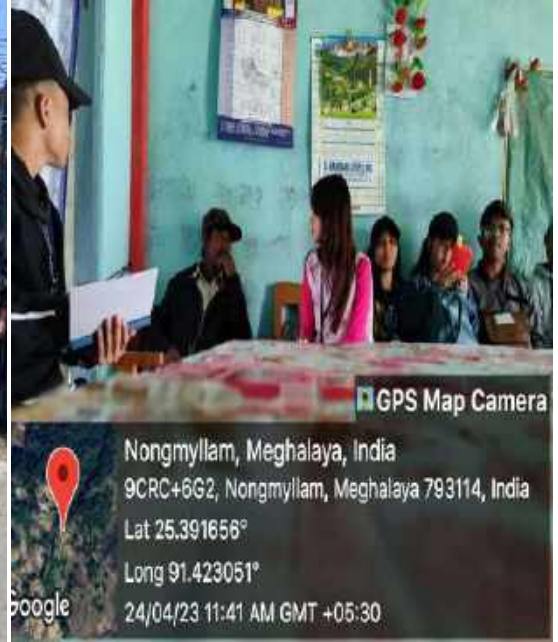
1. At 1:00 PM, Meeting with the Headman of Nongmyllam

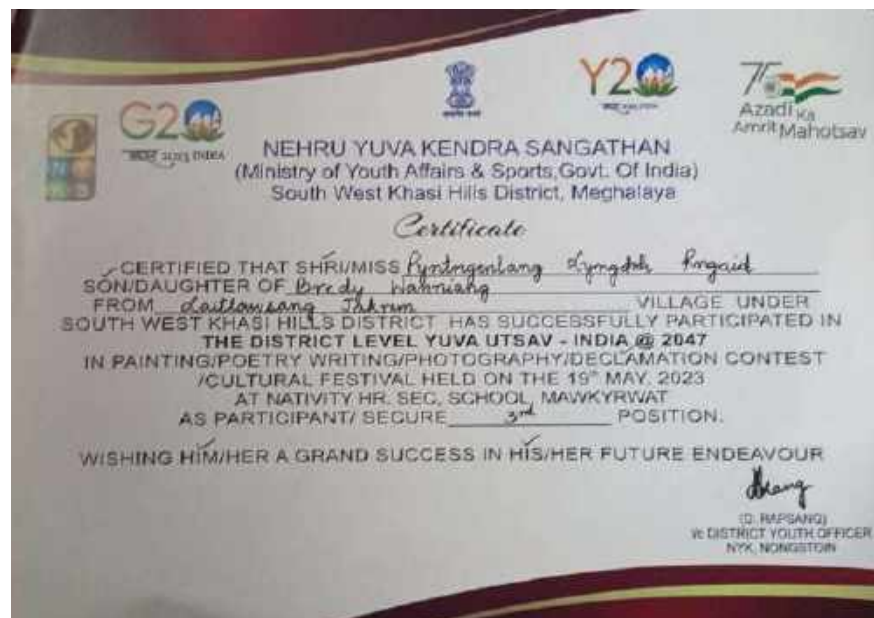
