## Report on the Inter-College Youth Festival 2023

### Day-1

The Youth Festival 2023 with the theme "Enjoy Life. Take Control. Stop HIV/AIDS." was organized by Red Ribbon Club of Sngap Syiem College, Mawkyrwat in collaboration with the Meghalaya Aids Control Society, Shillong in the college Campus on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> of September 2023.

The Programme started at 9:00 A.M in the morning with the registration at Room 4 by the teacher in charge. The name of the colleges and the members participated in this festival were: St. Xavier College Umoid, Sngap Syiem College, Mawkyrwat, and Nongstoin College, Nongstoin. The inaugural function started at 11:30 where the College welcomed all the dignitaries and guests who took part in the festivals. The first speech was given by the Chief Guest **Shri. D.P Wahlang, Chief Secretary of Meghalaya**. He motivated the students to have a good work ethics, balanced life, multiple activities, develop financial management and to belief in themselves. **Dr. Patricia Mukhim, Indian Social Activist, Writer, Journalist and the Editor of Shillong Times** also addressed the students on the Occasion. He also stressed on the balance between work and life. The Programme was followed by the speech of **Dr. F.R Lartang, DHMO, of South West Khasi Hills District**. He drew the attention of the audience on the theme of the Festival "Enjoy Life. Take Control. Stop HIV/AIDS". He also informed about the various treatment facilities available and the presence of several Treatment Centres in the different Districts of the state.

The Second Session commenced with the Skit Competition Hosted by Mr. J. Marbanniang and Miss P. Kharaswai. Mr. F.M Lyngdoh, Secretary, Ionglajong Musical and Cultural Organisation, Mr. S.E. Wanniang, RiMaram Folk Academy and Mr. Everlast Khongmalai, Cluster Program Manager MACS were the judges of the Skit competition. The first prize for the competition was awarded to St. Xavier College, Umoid. NCC Sngap Syiem College and B.SC Sngap Syiem College bagged the first and second runners up respectively.

This was followed by an interaction Programme among the Members of MACS and the students through questions -answers pattern. Gifts were presented to the students who took part actively in the interaction. The first day of the Youth Festival continued with the Cultural and Variety show performed by the students. The programs showcased the multiple skills of the students and also entertained everyone present in the Programme.

The evening session of the first day was started with a short speech given by Ms. Ibashisha Thongni Assistant Professor, Zoology Department. The day wined up with the different types of games conducted by Mr. Kynphamlang Nongiej and Mr. Pynntngen Lyngdoh.

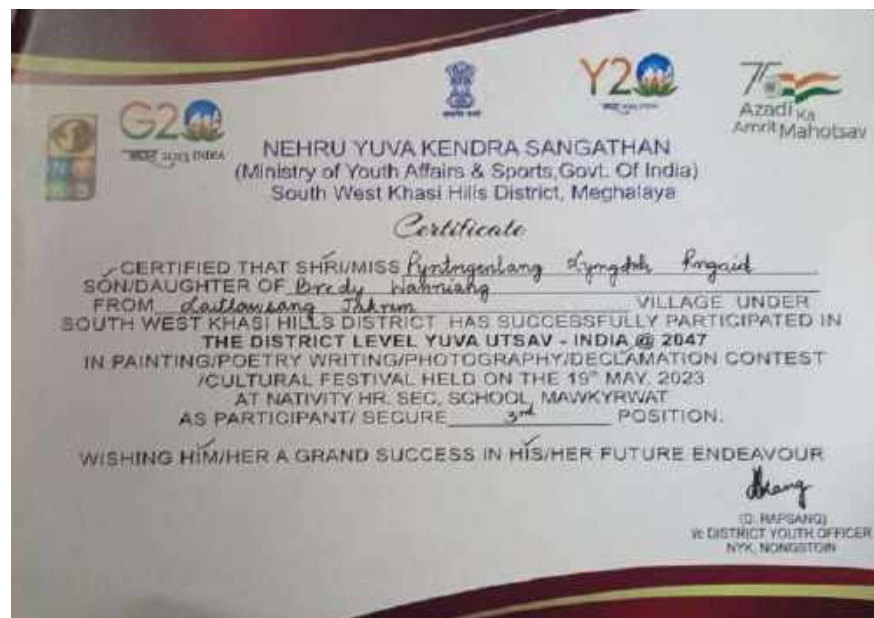
