Two best practices successfully implemented by the Institution

1. Students' Adaptability Practices:

For Below Poverty Line and self-supporting students, special attention was paid to them that attendance was lenient and flexible, remedial and extra classes were arranged for them to enable them receive the same education as those students who were regular in attending classes. For students with differently abled, the college exempted 33% of the fees to comply with the instruction of the Government and extra time during exams was also provided. Additionally the college provides a kind of scholarship to students who are excel in some field like arts, sports etc.

2. Summer introductory Course for FYUG as part of prepration in implimenting the NEP 2020

The Summer Introductory Course Committee is set up with a purpose to provide basic information and also guide the first Semesters Students about the various courses that the College is offering under the New Education Policy 2020. Besides, the committee is also formed in order to engage students in performing different activities/tasks and make them confident and learn and improve upon their skills and also help them in personality development.

The Committee will be organizing a two-week Summer Introductory Course programme for the first Semesters' Students only. The programme will start from 18th July to 28th July, 2023. Respective teachers will be engaged and assigned different roles during the two-week programme. During this two-week programme, teachers will also be engaged in mentoring the students.

Students will be dived in different club based on their choices and interest, the clubs that the college formed were, Art Club, Literary Club, Music & Choir Club, Dance Club, Adventure Sports Club, Eco-Green Club, Verbattle Club, Charity Club, Media & Publication Club, Drama Fashion Club, Culinary Club and Shark Tank Club.
